SENATOR DAN CLAITOR TAKES ON NEW RESPONSIBILITIES IN SENATE

APPOINTED TO SENATE AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

In only his second regular session, District 16 State Senator Dan Claitor (R-Baton Rouge) assumes a new leadership role in the Senate with his appointment to the Senate and Governmental Affairs Committee. This committee assignment, which comes early in his legislative career, is an important position in the state's lawmaking body. Sen. Claitor says that he is excited to have this opportunity.

"The coming year will be very important for the state," says Sen. Claitor, "We are soon to see the results of the 2010 census and I am honored to have the opportunity to assist with redistricting. I am dedicated to providing fair and equal representation to the people of Louisiana."

In addition to reapportionment, the Senate and Governmental Affairs Committee reviews measures dealing with electoral procedures, creation of committees, expenditures of funds by the legislature, governmental ethics, and other affairs of the senate and its employees and property.
