### WORK OF 2018 REGULAR SESSION BEGINS

Members of the Louisiana State Senate began the work of the 2018 Regular Legislative Session of the State Legislature at noon, Monday March 12, 2018. As the State Constitution dictates, the 2018 session is a "general" session where legislators can consider a wide-range of issues except for specific tax and revenue measures, which can only be considered in legislative sessions in odd numbered years. Over 1,100 measures have been pre-filed for consideration - 693 house bills and 455 senate bills.

Session is scheduled to end on June 4, but may end early to accommodate the possible need for a second special session to consider fiscal matters.
