SB 171	DUPLESSIS	EDUCATION DEPARTMENT Allows the Recovery School District to enroll any Louisiana student in a school or educational program under the district's jurisdiction.
SB 338	NEVERS	SCHOOLS Provides for group health insurance coverage for certain employees of the Recovery School District and Type 5 charter schools. (gov sig)
HB 350	LEGER	SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS Authorizes the Recovery School District to contract with for-profit providers for the operation of schools.
HB 463	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS Provides relative to the retention period for certain schools transferred to the Recovery School District and required reporting relative thereto.

HB 718	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides relative to the leave of absence granted by a local public school board to an employee who subsequently becomes employed in a charter school.
HB 720	SMITH, JANE	TEACHERS/CERTIFICATION Provides relative to requirements for granting certification to foreign associate teachers.
HB 909	MORRELL	SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS Provides relative to the time period of jurisdiction of the RSD over a school transferred to it.
HB 1105	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides relative to charter school funding.
HB 1145	FOIL	STUDENT/TUITION Authorizes the LSU Board of Supervisors to impose specific increases in tuition and nonresident attendance fee amounts for students at the Paul M. Hebert Law Center.
HB 1149	JACKSON, M.	PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS Authorizes the parish school board in certain parishes to name a stadium in honor of a former principal under certain circumstances.
HB 1164	MORRIS	PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS Authorizes school boards to name certain buildings after living persons.
HB 1184	LEGER	HIGHER EDUCATION Provides relative to certain entities that support public institutions of higher education.
HB 1247	RICHARDSON	STUDENTS Provides relative to the classroom placement of certain children.
HB 1314	JACKSON, M.	COLLEGES/SOUTHERN U Authorizes the Southern University Board of Supervisors to impose specific tuition increases at the law center.
HB 1325	DIXON	COLLEGES/PERSONNEL Provides relative to the use of sick leave for personal purposes by certain unclassified employees at public colleges and universities.
HB 1335	DOERGE	MUSEUMS Creates the Germantown Colony Museum as a museum in the Department of State.

- HCR 41 HARDY** **SCHOOLS** Requests BESE to adopt a policy requiring certain schools to suspend all extracurricular activities for students.
- HCR 65 TUCKER** **EDUCATION** Requests the Bd. of Regents to consider specific factors in developing the postsecondary education funding formula and budget recommendations for FY 2009-2010 and subsequent years relative to the LCTCS.
- HCR 76 GUILLORY, M** Requests BESE to study the effectiveness of the Dolly Parton Imagination Library in improving literacy among the state's preschool children and to submit a written report to the House and Senate education committees prior to the 2009 R.S.
- HCR 77 MORRIS** **SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES** Requests BESE to study the national board certification processes for certain school employees.
- HCR 100 LAFONTA** **STUDENT/ASSESSMENT** Requests BESE to study the negative and positive effects of high-stakes testing relative to the state's students, including but not limited to negative impacts on student dropout, retention, and attendance rates.
- HCR 101 HOFFMANN** **SCHOOLS** Requests city, parish, and other local public school boards to adopt policies recommending that classroom doors in certain schools be equipped with single action deadbolt locks that can be bolted from the inside.
