DOTD SETS PUBLIC MEETINGS TO DISCUSS THE UPCOMING I-210 BRIDGE PROJECT

SENATOR JOHNS ENCOURAGES ALL CITIZENS TO ATTEND AND HAVE THEIR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

District 27 State Senator Ronnie Johns (R- Lake Charles) is encouraging all citizens in the Lake Charles region to attend one of six informational public meetings for the upcoming I-210 Prien Lake Bridge project.

The I-210 project is expected to start this fall with and is estimated to be completed by Fall 2019. The project spans the entirety of the I-210 bridge and will start on the eastbound side. The meetings, hosted by the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development, will provide the public with an overview of the project, construction zones, and traffic.

In addition, the public will have an opportunity to have their concerns regarding the expected traffic delays and other safety issues addressed. LADOTD staff will make a presentation on the project and take questions. The public meetings have been scheduled as follows:
