**SB 8 LAFLEUR**

**PRIVILEGES/LIENS** Eliminates the requirement that the lessor of equipment on a construction project send a copy of the rental agreement to the landowner within ten days of equipment delivery to perfect his lien under the Private Works Act. (8/15/08)

**SB 37 DUPRE**

**NOTARIES** Authorizes certain ex officio notarial appointments by mayors in certain political subdivisions. (gov sig)

<b>SB 55</b>	<b>MORRISH</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Increases the jurisdictional limit for civil suit filing in the City Court of Jennings to \$35,000. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 91</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> Provides for two additional judgeships in the Twenty-Second Judicial District Court with specified jurisdiction. (gov sig)
<b>SB 101</b>	<b>MORRISH</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides for the transfer of surplus funds from the City Court of Jennings' civil fee account to the court's general operational fund. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 107</b>	<b>MORRISH</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides relative to certified court reporters for the Thirty-First Judicial District. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 179</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>FAMILY LAW</b> Provides relative to reserving fruits of property as separate property. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 184</b>	<b>MARIONNEAUX</b>	<b>CIVIL PROCEDURE</b> Removes authorization for a jury to have a written copy of instructions and charges in the jury room. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 258</b>	<b>GAUTREAUX, N.</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to the Department of Social Services.
<b>SB 264</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>DOMESTIC VIOLENCE</b> Provides with respect to domestic abuse assistance. (gov sig)
<b>SB 303</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides relative to introduction of foreign business records in criminal proceedings. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 492</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>FAMILY LAW</b> Provides relative to actions for failure to exercise rights pursuant to a court-ordered visitation schedule. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 608</b>	<b>DUPLESSIS</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> Provides for the term of office of a judge elected to fill a vacancy of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court. (gov sig)
