SB 139	QUINN	SEIZURES/SALES Provides for an increase in the amount of the homestead exemption from seizure and sale. (gov sig)
SB 163	THOMPSON	LIABILITY Provides an exemption from liability for agritourism professionals. (gov sig)
SB 186	MARIONNEAUX	PRESCRIPTION Extends the one year prescription for civil actions generally to two years. (8/15/08)

SB 211	MARIONNEAUX	CIVIL PROCEDURE Increase the monetary amount in controversy necessary to request a jury trial. (8/15/08)
SB 213	MARIONNEAUX	CIVIL PROCEDURE Constitutional amendment to provide for the appellate jurisdiction of a court of appeal and to provide that appellate review extends only to questions of law. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
SB 220	QUINN	FAMILY LAW Provides relative to possession and use of family residence or community property in the event of divorce. (8/15/08)
SB 222	QUINN	LIABILITY Creates the Asbestos and Silica Claims Medical Criteria Act. (8/15/08)
SB 277	CROWE	COURTS Provides relative to recusal of judges. (gov sig)
SB 278	CROWE	CIVIL PROCEDURE Allows a party in a civil action to substitute a judge of right under certain circumstances. (gov sig)
SB 307	DONAHUE	CIVIL PROCEDURE Prohibits recovery for loss of enjoyment of life as a separate element of damages apart from pain and suffering damages and prohibits an instruction to the jury which separates loss of enjoyment of life from pain and suffering. (8/15/08)
SB 308	DONAHUE	CIVIL PROCEDURE Provides for a pre-trial hearing regarding the qualifications and admissibility of testimony of expert witnesses. (gov sig)
SB 320	CASSIDY	MALPRACTICE Constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to determine limits for professional medical damages in medical and health care liability claims. (2/3 - CABs1(A))
SB 348	QUINN	CIVIL PROCEDURE Provides relative to signing of pleadings and sanctions. (8/15/08)
SB 416	MURRAY	COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS Enacts the Uniform Unincorporated Association Act. (08/15/08)

- SB 425 MURRAY CIVIL PROCEDURE** Provide for the appeal venue from a decision of the office of community development with the Road Home program. (8/15/08)
- SB 496 CROWE CIVIL PROCEDURE** Provides relative to recusation of judges. (8/15/08)
- SB 509 MICHOT MALPRACTICE** Revises definitions under the private Medical Malpractice Act. (gov sig)
- SB 560 HEBERT EXPROPRIATION** Requires approval of a majority of the elected members of each house of the legislature prior to the expropriation of property.
- SB 652 MICHOT MALPRACTICE** Provides relative to the definitions and general applications of medical malpractice. (8/15/08)
- SB 716 MARTINY JUVENILE JUSTICE** Provides for the confidentiality of juvenile records. (8/15/08)
- SB 758 BROOME CHILDREN** Provides relative to intrafamily adoptions. (8/15/08)
- SB 781 JACKSON, L. CHILDREN** Provides relative to multi-disciplinary interaction in cases of child abuse or neglect. (gov sig)
