**MALPRACTICE** Provides relative to the definitions and general applications of medical malpractice. (8/15/08)

**HCR 27 CONNICK**

**MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC** Provides relative to certified copies of state identification to be used as documentation in obtaining a duplicate or replacement ID card

**HCR 57 FOIL**

**MORTGAGES** Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study and make recommendations on the revision, reorganization, and consolidation of the registry laws relative to mortgage and privilege inscriptions

<b>HB 17</b>	<b>ELLINGTON</b>	<b>COURTS/COURT REPORTERS</b> Increases court reporter fees for transcriptions in the 37 <sup>th</sup> JDC
<b>HB 27</b>	<b>JOHNSON</b>	<b>COURTS/MAYORS</b> Authorizes the appointment of a court magistrate for the mayor's court in the town of Evergreen
<b>HB 98</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>STATE AGENCIES</b> Clarifies the master-servant relationship in connection with liability of political subdivisions
<b>HB 143</b>	<b>CROMER</b>	<b>COURTS/CITY</b> Provides for the civil jurisdictional amount in the City Court of Slidell, small claims division
<b>HB 144</b>	<b>CROMER</b>	<b>COURTS/CITY</b> Provides for the qualification for office for the City Court of Slidell
<b>HB 157</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for proceedings on the 24 <sup>th</sup> JDC Environmental docket
<b>HB 158</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>DOMICILE</b> Provides for the continuous revision of law relative to domicile
<b>HB 215</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Provides for qualifications of medical expert witnesses in certain medical malpractice actions
<b>HB 298</b>	<b>ELLINGTON</b>	<b>COURTS/CITY</b> Authorizes City Court of Winnsboro to transfer surplus or unclaimed funds to the court's operational fund
<b>HB 495</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS</b> Provides relative to evacuations, curfews, and essential or critical workforce during a disaster or state emergency
<b>HB 497</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Provides for the expenditure of the Internet access fee for the clerk of the 21 <sup>st</sup> JDC
<b>HB 527</b>	<b>BURNS, TIM</b>	<b>CIVIL/DONATIONS</b> Provides for the continuous revision of the law regarding donations
<b>HB 548</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the continuous revision of the Code of Civil Procedure

- HB 887 LABRUZZO MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL** Provides relative to limiting medical malpractice recovery in certain circumstances
- HB 1118 CHAMPAGNE CRIMINAL/VICTIMS** Increases the salary for each victims assistance coordinator in the judicial districts
- HB 1179 FOIL TRUSTS** Provides for the appointment of a registered agent for service of process
- HB 1204 WILLIAMS JUDGES/JUSTICE OF PEACE** Provides relative to justice of the peace courts in Caddo Parish
