**SB 307 DONAHUE**

**CIVIL PROCEDURE** Prohibits recovery for loss of enjoyment of life as a separate element of damages apart from pain and suffering damages and prohibits an instruction to the jury which separates loss of enjoyment of life from pain and suffering. (8/15/08)

<b>SB 700</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>INSURERS</b> Provides for data matching and cooperation with any company licensed to issue insurance policies in the state. (8/15/08)
<b>HB 16</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>COURTS/CITY</b> Increases the civil jurisdictional limitations of the city courts of Baker, Baton Rouge, New Orleans, and Zachary
<b>HB 29</b>	<b>MORRIS</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Provides with respect to the taking of testimony of a protected person
<b>HB 55</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>CIVIL/LAW</b> Prohibits the use of counter letters
<b>HB 129</b>	<b>MONICA</b>	<b>COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE</b> Increases the civil jurisdictional amount of justice of the peace courts
<b>HB 134</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>MORTGAGES</b> Provides relative to the removal of mortgage inscriptions
<b>HB 136</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Provides relative to the destruction of useless records
<b>HB 138</b>	<b>GEYMANN</b>	<b>COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE</b> Provides with respect to the jurisdiction in which justice of the peace constables can effectuate service of process
<b>HB 139</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>CHILDRENS CODE</b> Provides relative to the destruction of certain inactive and closed domestic relations and adoption records
<b>HB 158</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>DOMICILE</b> Provides for the continuous revision of law relative to domicile
<b>HB 283</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CHILDREN/CARE</b> Provides procedures for child in need of care proceedings
<b>HB 388</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE</b> Provides relative to component parts of immovable property
<b>HB 393</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>JUDGMENTS/CIVIL</b> Provides for the confirmation of certain default judgments
<b>HB 424</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CIVIL/VENUE</b> Provides relative to proper venue for a suit on a promissory note

<b>HB 633</b>	<b>ANDERS</b>	<b>LIABILITY/CIVIL</b> Provides a limitation of liability for certain agritourism activities
<b>HB 681</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>CHILDRENS CODE</b> Provides with respect to the duties of peace officers or probation officers upon taking a child into custody
<b>HB 682</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>CHILDRENS CODE</b> Amends provisions regarding identification of children taken into custody for delinquent acts
<b>HB 768</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>SEIZURES/SALES</b> Provides for the prescriptive period and method of cancellation of a notice of seizure
<b>HB 781</b>	<b>WADDELL</b>	<b>NOTARIES</b> Provides for unlawful exercise of notary powers
<b>HB 815</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>PRESCRIPTION</b> Provides for the prescriptive period for actions involving the sale of certain immovable property
<b>HB 828</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Provides relative to the electronic filing of certain instruments
<b>HB 840</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/COMMERCIAL</b> Provides for the definition of felony
<b>HB 863</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>PRESCRIPTION</b> Provides for two-year prescription for actions involving a power of attorney
<b>HB 879</b>	<b>SCHRODER</b>	<b>COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE</b> Provides for one justice of the peace for Ward 3 of St. Tammany Parish
<b>HB 887</b>	<b>LABRUZZO</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Provides relative to limiting medical malpractice recovery in certain circumstances
<b>HB 1004</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS</b> Provides with respect to the issuance of subpoenas directing the testimony of legislative staff regarding matters of legislative speech and debate
<b>HB 1008</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>PROPERTY</b> Requires the filing of an act of immobilization of a manufactured home with the

secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections

- HB 1127 HUTTER**      **LIABILITY/CIVIL** Provides a limitation of liability for religious organizations providing assistance during a state of emergency
- HB 1129 HAZEL**      **LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS** Provides relative to law enforcement officers under investigation
- HB 1354 LOPINTO**      **COMMERCE** Provides relative to price gouging during emergencies or hurricanes
- HB 1356 ABRAMSON**      **PRESCRIPTION** Provides for the prescriptive period for judgments, liens, and privileges against the state
