SB 642 MARTINY CRIMINAL PROCEDURE Provides for revocation of parole for a technical violation. (8/15/08)

SB 749	CRAVINS, JR.	JUVENILE JUSTICE Authorizes the Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission to make recommendations concerning the Jetson Youth Center-East Baton Rouge Parish Unit. (8/15/08)
SB 785	GAUTREAUX, N.	HORSE RACING Provides relative to horse racing and pari-mutuel facilities. (gov sig)
HB 23	GREENE	CRIMINAL/CONVICTIONS Authorizes the court to admit to bail a person arrested for extradition for commission of certain offenses
HB 46	MILLS	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES Reorganizes Schedules I, II, III, and V of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law to make those provisions consistent with federal law
HB 93	ST. GERMAIN	LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS Amends provisions regarding rights of law enforcement officers under investigation
HB 118	BALDONE	CORRECTIONS Amends the definition of "contraband" with regard to items prohibited in state correctional facilities
HB 126	BALDONE	CRIMINAL/VICTIMS Provides with respect to providing crime victims with recent photographs of inmates
HB 631	SCHRODER	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides with respect to the use of videotapes of protected persons in criminal prosecutions
HB 632	SCHRODER	CRIME Creates crime for wrongful possession of recordings or videotapes of protected persons
HB 634	PONTI	CRIMINAL/VICTIMS Prohibits persons from contacting crime victims
HB 1136	PEARSON	PARDON/PAROLE Provides that law enforcement officers in addition to parole officers may search a person on parole without a warrant

LAW ENFORCEMENT Amends provisions of peace officer training standards with respect to reserve or part-time officers
