HCR 95	BURRELL	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Requests study of providing substance abuse counseling in all jails and prisons in the state of Louisiana
HB 25	GEYMANN	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides for verification of citizenship or immigration status upon arrest
HB 120	WOOTON	CORRECTIONS Amends provisions of law regarding temporary release of inmates

HB 123	WOOTON	CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS Provides for the release of certain information pertaining to a prisoner's activities while incarcerated
HB 124	WOOTON	CRIME Amends penalty provisions regarding malfeasance in office regarding sexual conduct with incarcerated persons
HB 125	GUILLORY, ELBERT	CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS Provides with respect to the permissible use of interest earned from inmates' compensation accounts
HB 127	WOOTON	CORRECTIONS Provides relative to eligibility for intensive incarceration and intensive parole supervision
HB 206	WOOTON	CORRECTIONS Provides for the entity receiving supervised release payments
HB 289	WOOTON	PARDON/PAROLE Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to redesignate the provisions of law regarding intensive incarceration and intensive parole supervision as a separate statute
HB 399	WOOTON	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Amends concealed handgun permit provisions
HB 460	TUCKER	JUVENILES Provides for the membership of the Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission
HB 505	WOOTON	RETIREMENT/PUBLIC SYSTEM Authorizes probation and parole officers to purchase their firearms upon retirement
HB 531	WOOTON	CORRECTIONS Amends provisions of law regarding the definition of a technical violation for the purposes of revoking probation or parole
HB 748	WOOTON	CORRECTIONS Provides for the reimbursement to private health care providers for costs of extraordinary medical expenses of inmates under certain circumstances
HB 778	RICHMOND	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Extends until August 31, 2014, the period within which to file an application for DNA testing

HB 1153 HAZEL **CRIME** Prohibits wearing or possessing body armor on school property

HB 1357 GEYMANN **CRIME** Creates the crime of harboring, concealing, or sheltering an alien

HB 1358 GEYMANN **CRIME** Prohibits the transportation of an alien
