SB 594	GRAY	CLERKS OF COURT Requires the recording and reporting by clerks of court of the use of peremptory challenges. (8/15/08)
SB 600	SMITH, JOHN	WEAPONS Provides relative to permit qualification for concealed handguns. (8/15/08)
SB 682	SHAW	ATTORNEY GENERAL Provides relative to the Louisiana Sexual Assault Task Force. (gov sig)
SB 707	ERDEY	LIABILITY Provides immunity for members and employees of the regional juvenile justice commissions. (08/15/08)
SB 721	CHAISSON	EVIDENCE Provides for challenges to the admissibility of blood alcohol concentration test results into evidence. (gov sig)
SB 752	WALSWORTH	DWI Provides for an electronic signature of an officer issuing a report that a person submits or refuses to submit to a chemical test, provides for certification of the report and penalties for false certification of the report. (8/15/08)
SB 784	GAUTREAUX, N.	FUNDS/FUNDING Permits the use of purse supplements in races above or less than \$20,000. (8/15/08)
SB 791	GAUTREAUX, N.	RACING Creates the Horsemen's Self-Help Pension Program. (8/15/08)
SB 803	ERDEY	FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS Provides for the issuance of explosive licenses including more stringent license requirements and classes of license. (8/15/08)

SB 804 **MARIONNEAUX** **GAMING** Amends the Louisiana Gaming and Control Law. (8/15/08)

HB 163 **LIGI** **CRIME** Creates the crime of criminal damage to property by defacing with graffiti
