<b>SB 295</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>EXPROPRIATION</b> Constitutional amendment to remove certain restrictions on the disposition of blighted property expropriated in the city of New Orleans and in the city of Baton Rouge. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 318</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>LOCAL FINANCE</b> Authorizes the creation of a tax increment financing district in the town of Richwood. (Gov sig)
<b>SB 319</b>	<b>CASSIDY</b>	<b>TAX/LOCAL</b> Establishes a procedure for creating neighborhood crime prevention and security districts and levying parcel fees in any parish or municipality. (Gov sig)
<b>SB 564</b>	<b>GRAY</b>	<b>SPECIAL DISTRICTS</b> Creates and provides for the Maple Area Residents Security Tax District. (8/15/08)
