HB 296	DANAHAY	DISTRICTS/RECREATION Provides relative to community center and playground districts in Calcasieu Parish
HB 312	ARNOLD	ASSESSORS Provides that the Orleans Parish Assessor shall be responsible for all of the obligations of the board of assessors of Orleans Parish
HB 401	MORRELL	DISTRICTS/TAXING Creates the Gentilly Taxing District in Orleans Parish
HB 408	HOFFMANN	ASSESSORS Provides for certain additional continuing education requirements for assessors

HB 419	EDWARDS	PARISH/POLICE JURIES Increases maximum allowable monthly salary for police jurors and authorizes a police jury to increase the salary of the police jury president
HB 438	LIGI	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Provides relative to drug testing of employees of local governmental subdivisions
HB 523	CONNICK	PARISH/JEFFERSON Authorizes Jefferson Parish to take certain actions in court relative to certain owners of deleterious premises
HB 524	LEBAS	TAX/TAXATION Authorizes the Evangeline Parish Assessment District to provide for an automobile expense allowance for the assessor
HB 591	DANAHAY	POLICE/LOCAL Provides relative to the salaries of certain members of the police department of the city of Sulphur
HB 604	MILLS	TAX/HOTEL OCCUPANCY Provides relative to the levy of hotel taxes in certain parishes
HB 665	MILLS	TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL Authorizes municipal governing authorities to create sales tax districts with the power to levy an additional 1% local sales and use tax
HB 733	SCHRODER	ENVIRONMENT/LITTERING Provides with respect to the authority of parish governments to enforce litter abatement ordinances
HB 903	LORUSSO	PROPERTY/SUBSTANDARD Authorizes certain agencies and entities in Orleans Parish to enforce health, safety, and welfare statutes and ordinances in any court of competent jurisdiction and establishes an environmental docket in the Civil District Court for the parish of Orleans to hear any such matter
HB 905	TUCKER	DISTRICTS/SPECIAL Provides that certain members of community development district boards shall be appointed rather than elected
HB 928	JONES, SAM	CULTURE/REC/TOUR DEPT Provides for the creation of the Louisiana Historic Cemetery Register

- HB 931 GEYMANN DISTRICTS/SPECIAL** Provides relative to the Calcasieu Parish Gaming Revenue District
- HB 980 BURNS, HENRY CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE & POL** Authorizes rehearings by fire and police civil service boards on disciplinary matters under certain circumstances
- HB 1005 ABRAMSON DISTRICTS/NEIGHBORHOOD** Provides relative to the Audubon Area Security District
- HB 1023 BARRAS DISTRICTS/ECONOMIC DEVEL** Creates the Iberia Economic Development Authority
- HB 1057 NOWLIN TAX/HOTEL OCCUPANCY** Authorizes the city of Natchitoches to levy and collect an additional hotel occupancy tax within the city
- HB 1093 CONNICK PARISH/GOVERN AUTHORITY** Authorizes a parish governing authority to place certain charges of property owners on the ad valorem tax rolls of the parish
- HB 1108 BARROW PARISH/EAST BATON ROUGE** Provides relative to the East Baton Rouge Redevelopment Authority
- HB 1206 DOVE TOURISM** Creates the South La. Wetlands Discovery Center in Terrebonne Parish
- HB 1252 MONTOUCET FIRE PROTECTION** Provides relative to the maximum number of consecutive hours on duty and the minimum number of consecutive hours off duty for firemen under certain circumstances
- HB 1276 CHAMPAGNE DISTRICTS/WATERWORKS** Authorizes the Vermilion Parish governing authority to increase the per diem paid to the board of commissioners of Southeast Waterworks District No. 2
- HB 1304 BALDONE DISTRICTS/SPECIAL** Authorizes increase in per diem for the board of commissioners of recreation districts in certain parishes
