SCR 36 MORRISH

CONGRESS Memorializes Congress to oppose the authorization of offshore aquaculture in the Gulf of Mexico.

SCR 38 DUPRE

CONGRESS Memorializes Congress to extend Louisiana's seaward boundary in the Gulf of Mexico to nine geographical miles.

SB 216 DUPRE

MINERALS Constitutional amendment to provide for the interruption of prescription of mineral rights on certain lands donated to the state. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

- SB 349** **DUPRE** **COASTAL RESOURCES** Provides relative to lands acquired by the state or political subdivision. (See Act)
- SB 367** **DUPRE** **COASTAL PROTECT/RES AUTH** Provides relative to Louisiana Coastal Protection, Conservation, Restoration, and Management. (8/15/08)
- SB 411** **MCPHERSON** **WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT** Creates the Coastal Land Stewardship Authority. (8/15/08)
- SB 697** **DUPRE** **TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL** Provides for donations of refunds of individual and corporate income tax, corporate franchise tax, and sales tax to the Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund and for donations in addition to such taxes. (gov sig)
