| <b>SB 31</b> | <b>KOSTELKA</b> | <b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Requires that campaign finance reports include the name of the employer of any person making a contribution or for which the aggregate amount of total contributions made by the individual during the reporting period exceeds \$250. (1/1/10) |
| <b>SCR 2</b> | <b>MURRAY</b>   | <b>IMMOVABLE PROPERTY</b> Creates a special committee to study and develop recommendations for facilitating the ability of co-owners of inherited immovable property to make their titles merchantable.   |

<b>SB 12</b>	<b>MICHOT</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Requires statewide elected officials, members of the Board of Ethics, and legislators to disclose certain financial information on an annual basis and requires candidates for statewide elective office and the legislature to disclose such information at the time of qualifying. (gov sig)
<b>SB 14</b>	<b>MARIONNEAUX</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Requires the name of third-party entities on the face of paid political advertisements. (1/1/10)
<b>SB 18</b>	<b>SCALISE</b>	<b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION</b> Creates the office of state inspector general in the office of the governor. (gov sig)
<b>SB 19</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>LOBBYING</b> Prohibits any expenditure by a legislative or executive lobbyist on a legislator or executive branch official. (gov sig)
<b>SB 20</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS</b> Prohibits an elected official from qualifying from any other elected office while holding his office. (gov sig)
<b>SB 21</b>	<b>MCPHERSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Requires all expenditures attributable to each "public servant" to be included in the report required to be filed by registered lobbyists and provides for exceptions for group occasions.
<b>SB 22</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits legislators and certain other elected officials from entering into contracts with the state and certain political subdivisions thereof unless competitively bid under the Public Bid Law. (gov sig)
<b>SB 23</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Prohibits the appointment or nomination of certain campaign contributors. (gov sig)
<b>SB 24</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Deletes exception for free tickets and prohibit any preferential status or treatment in purchase of tickets to athletic and cultural events based on an individual's status as a public servant. (gov sig)
<b>SB 25</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides that no elected official may appoint or nominate any person who contributed to the elected official's campaign for that office. (gov sig)

<b>SB 26</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Requires certain financial disclosure by statewide elected officials, legislators, and certain local elected officials.
<b>SB 28</b>	<b>MICHOT</b>	<b>LOBBYING</b> Provides relative to lobbyist. (gov sig)
<b>SB 27</b>	<b>MCPHERSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits legislators and other public servants from receiving tickets from lobbyists and public entities. (gov sig)
<b>SB 29</b>	<b>MARIONNEAUX</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Requires the filing of campaign reports by qualified 26 U.S.C.A. §527 political organizations regarding all persons making contributions to the organization, the amount of such contributions, and the expenditures made by the organizations.
<b>SB 45</b>	<b>MCPHERSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides for certain prohibitions and restrictions on lobbyists expenditures involving certain public servants. (gov sig)
<b>SB 46</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Requires any legislator who receives compensation for working on the campaign of another candidate to report such receipt annually. (3/30/08)
<b>SB 47</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Provides for felony violations of election campaign finance law. (3/30/08)
<b>SB 56</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits a former public servant from being employed by or entering into a contractual agreement with certain persons or entities with which he has participated in a transaction involving his agency for two years after his public service. (gov sig)
<b>SB 57</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Expands prohibitions regarding assistance to certain persons after termination of public service by certain public servants. (gov sig)
<b>SB 64</b>	<b>DONAHUE</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides restrictions and disclosure requirements involving contractual arrangements between certain public servants and certain persons and entities. (1/9/12)

**SB 65**      **SCALISE**                      **CAMPAIGN FINANCE** Provides relative to campaign contributions. (gov sig)

**SB 66**      **ADLEY**                              **ETHICS** Requires a two-thirds vote to add an exception to the standards and requirements of the Code of Ethics. (gov sig)
