SB 3	CROWE	MARKETING/PROMOTION Designates Plaquemines Parish as the "Gateway to Louisiana and America." (gov sig)
SB 6	MURRAY	LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS Designates Sazerac as the official state cocktail. (8/15/08)
SB 23	CROWE	LOBBYING Requires the Board of Ethics to include certain information in the lobbyist expenditure report forms.

- SB 53 SHAW ETHICS** Provides that any complaint filed anonymously with the Board of Ethics shall not be investigated or addressed by the board. (8/15/08)
- SB 56 MICHOT ETHICS** Allows a member of an appointed board or commission to recuse himself in the case of a conflict of interest.
- SB 115 MARTINY ELECTION CODE** Provides a procedure for qualifying as a candidate by nominating petition whenever qualifying is reopened for an office after the death of a candidate. (7/1/08)
- SB 136 QUINN TELECOMMUNICATIONS** Authorizes certain technical evaluation committees to meet and conduct business through teleconferencing and video conferencing. (gov sig)
- SB 167 MURRAY LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS** Allows meetings of legislative committees held in the interim between sessions to be conducted by video conference.(gov sig)
- SB 180 MICHOT GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION** Transfers the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana (CODOFIL) to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism. (7/1/08)
- SB 488 THOMPSON HOMELAND SECURITY** Provides for the director of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness to include representatives of the legislature in the state emergency operations plan (EOP). (8/15/08)
