SB 364	DORSEY	ETHICS Prohibits certain public servants and former public servants from representing persons for compensation before certain governmental entities of its officials or agencies. (gov sig)
SB 369	MARIONNEAUX	ETHICS Provides relative to the Governmental Code of Ethics. (gov sig)
SB 370	DORSEY	ETHICS Provides certain restrictions and prohibitions concerning disaster or emergency contracts and certain public servants. (gov sig)
SB 372	DORSEY	ETHICS Provides relative to recusal by certain public servants in certain matters when serving as a designee of the governor on a board or commission. (gov sig)
SB 409	HEBERT	CAMPAIGN FINANCE Provides certain restrictions and disclosure requirements for funds expended on electronic media for certain candidates for public office. (1/1/09)
SB 428	CASSIDY	VOTERS/VOTING Authorizes the registrars of colleges and universities to register citizens to vote. (gov sig)
SB 499	CROWE	LOBBYING Provides exception to the definition of lobbyist. (gov sig)
SB 651	DORSEY	ETHICS Removes certain provisions requiring certain public servants and affiliated persons and entities to file annual reports with the Board of Ethics relative to certain contracts with state government. (8/15/08)

SB 691	LONG	ETHICS Provides laws intended to deter candidates and their supporters from filing false or frivolous complaints with governmental entities that have investigative authority, and to deter using such complaints or investigative information to gain an advantage against an opponent by imposing criminal penalties.
