SB 62 MICHOT

CAMPAIGN FINANCE Limits the amount of a loan that a candidate can make to his own campaign to 10% of the total funds raised from other sources. (8/15/08)

SB 438	L. JACKSON	CHILDREN Places the Children's Cabinet under the authority of the legislature. (8/15/08)
SB 691	LONG	ETHICS Provides laws intended to deter candidates and their supporters from filing false or frivolous complaints with governmental entities that have investigative authority, and to deter using such complaints or investigative information to gain an advantage against an opponent by imposing criminal penalties. (8/15/08)
HB 82	LAFONTA	ETHICS Prohibits persons from serving on or being employed by any board or commission under certain circumstances
HB 180	GALLOT	SUNSET LAW Provides that the Department of Veterans Affairs will begin to terminate operations on July 1, 2010, unless re-created as provided by law
HB 216	GALLOT	REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES Provides for the districts and election sections for the Court of Appeal for the Second Circuit
HB 304	MORRELL	ETHICS Prohibits members of boards and commissions in New Orleans from entering into certain contracts with the city
HB 340	MORRELL	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires certain administrators of state correctional institutions to file certain financial disclosure statements
HB 446	GREENE	SECRETARY OF STATE Removes the requirement that Acts of the legislature be published in the official journal of the state

HB 503	GALLOT	BOARDS/COMMISSIONS Transfers appointing authority of members of certain boards and commissions to the lieutenant governor
HB 635	GREENE	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires financial disclosure by certain persons
HB 678	GREENE	ETHICS Provides relative to gubernatorial transitions including contribution and expenditure reports
HB 790	FOIL	ELECTION DAYS Removes provisions for the July election date
HB 842	GALLOT	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Provides relative to financial disclosure
HB 854	LAMBERT	JUDGES Provides for geographical election sections for first district of First Circuit Court of Appeals
HB 911	GALLOT	ETHICS/CODE Provides relative to the acceptance of admission to certain events by public servants
HB 960	GALLOT	ELECTIONS Provides for a program for the conduct of early voting at additional locations
HB 997	MORRELL	ETHICS Prohibits former public servants in the office of the governor, including the division of administration, from being employed by or entering into a contract with certain persons
HB 1002	GALLOT	ETHICS Provides relative to certain prohibited contracts
HB 1017	GALLOT	ELECTIONS Makes various changes to the election code
