<b>HB 32</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>MORTGAGES</b> Provides relative to the filling of a vacancy in the office of recorder of mortgages in Orleans Parish
<b>HB 82</b>	<b>LAFONTA</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits persons from serving on or being employed by any board or commission under certain circumstances
<b>HB 176</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Requires disclosure by certain elected officials of certain information relative to employment and appointment of campaign contributors and certain other contributors
<b>HB 326</b>	<b>ARNOLD</b>	<b>SECRETARY OF STATE</b> Provides for changes to fees charged by the secretary of state
<b>HB 430</b>	<b>PETERSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Repeals provision for recusal for members of the Board of Commissioners of the Port of New Orleans and removes provisions permitting certain persons to serve on the board
<b>HB 876</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>MINORITIES</b> Creates the Louisiana Council on Social Status of Black Men and Boys
<b>HB 906</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Requires the Board of Ethics to send information regarding the complaint immediately to the accused
<b>HB 935</b>	<b>FANNIN</b>	<b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION</b> Transfers certain agencies from the office of the governor to certain departments in the executive branch of state government and places certain agencies in the division of administration

- HB 988 WADDELL LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS** Provides relative to the district offices of members of the legislature
- HB 1011 LAFONTA VOTERS/VOTING** Requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to provide certain information concerning registration and reinstatement and voter registration applications to certain persons
- HB 1063 TUCKER LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS** Provides relative to the salary and benefits for legislative assistants
- HB 1175 MONTOUCET ETHICS** Provides relative to the ethics code exception for the immediate family member of a legislator being a registered lobbyist or lobbying
- HB 1181 LORUSSO ETHICS/CODE** Excludes certain members of the National Guard from the definition of "public employee" for purposes of the Code of Governmental Ethics
- HB 1337 AUBERT ETHICS/CODE** To provide an exception to the ethics code relative to certain transactions for governmental services
- HB 1372 SMILEY BOARDS/COMMISSIONS** Abolishes certain boards, commissions, authorities, and like entities
