| <b>SR 30</b>  | <b>DONAHUE</b> | <b>CAPITAL OUTLAY</b> Requires the Senate president to appoint a special Senate committee to conduct a comprehensive study of the TIMED program.                      |
| <b>SB 145</b> | <b>QUINN</b>   | <b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Requires the parish board of election supervisors to inform certain voters if their ballots were rejected and the reason for rejection. (7/1/08) |
| <b>SB 221</b> | <b>QUINN</b>   | <b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Changes the hours the polls are required to be open on election day. (1/1/09)  |

<b>SB 333</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Requires withdrawal notice to be placed next to the precinct register. (7/1/08)
<b>SB 428</b>	<b>CASSIDY</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Authorizes the registrars of colleges and universities to register citizens to vote. (gov sig)
<b>SB 479</b>	<b>CASSIDY</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Permits exploratory efforts by prospective candidate without requiring disclosure reports. (1/9/09)
<b>SB 490</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Limits the amount a candidate may loan to his own campaign. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 499</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>LOBBYING</b> Provides exception to the definition of lobbyist. (gov sig)
<b>SB 691</b>	<b>LONG</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides laws intended to deter candidates and their supporters from filing false or frivolous complaints with governmental entities that have investigative authority, and to deter using such complaints or investigative information to gain an advantage against an opponent by imposing criminal penalties. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 718</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to financial disclosure requirements of members of state boards and commissions. (See Act)
<b>SB 741</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to financial disclosure requirements of members of the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges. (See Act)
<b>SB 756</b>	<b>B. GAUTREAUX</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES</b> Provides for the legislative actuary. (7/1/08)
