**LOUISIANA STATE FIREMEN’S ASSOCIATION HONORS SENATE PRESIDENT ALARIO
AS ITS 2019 LEGISLATOR OF THE YEAR**

The Louisiana State Firemen’s Association (L.S.F.A.) honored State Senate President John A. Alario, Jr. as the Roy A. Robichaux, Sr. 2019 Legislator of the Year. The award was presented to President Alario on August 10, 2019 during the organization’s 114th Annual Conference.

President Alario was chosen as a recipient of the award because of his steadfast support of measures that continuously promote and protect the interests of the firefighters of Louisiana.

“Every single day firefighters risk their lives to ensure the safety of our communities,” said President Alario. “I am incredibly humbled to receive this recognition and I am happy to have done what I could for these brave men and women who put their lives on the line to protect our homes and loved ones.”

The L.S.F.A. was founded in 1903 with the purpose of creating an alliance among its members and promoting and protecting the best interests of the Fire Service Personnel of Louisiana. The organization currently has 12,550 members and 340 fire departments across the state. Its members include professional and volunteer firefighters, as well as combination fire departments.
