## SENATE JUDICIARY B COMMITTEE TO HOLD SPECIAL MEETING IN NEW ORLEANS

### FOCUS ON LOUISIANA SUPREME COURT JUSTICE ISSUES AND NEW ORLEANS POLICE DATA COLLECTION

The Senate Judiciary B Committee, chaired by District 3 State Senator Jean-Paul "JP" Morrell (D-New Orleans), will hold a special hearing in New Orleans to discuss and gather information on the Louisiana Supreme Court Justice issues and the New Orleans Police Department's policies on data collection during traffic and pedestrian stops, known as field interview cards. The special meeting is set for Wednesday, July 25, 2012.

"While these two issues are very different, they are both extremely important to the people of New Orleans and our entire state," said Sen. Morrell. "It is imperative that we examine both of these subjects and hear public testimony so that we in the legislature can have a proper understanding of the issues impacting our citizens."
