State Senator Jonathan Perry Earns A+ from Louisiana Sheriff's Association for 2012 Session Work

State Senator Jonathan Perry received an A+ from the Louisiana Sheriff's Association (LSA) for his work during the 2012 Legislative session. Senator Perry was also recognized for his 100% support of LSA's voting recommendations.

Each year, the Louisiana Sheriff's Association works to provide a united voice for sheriffs across the state and to promote improved public safety. This year's legislative package was developed after months of collaboration with Louisiana sheriffs, who submitted legislative proposals regarding issues that were most important to them.

"To be recognized as a friend in the Senate by the LSA is certainly something I'm very proud of. It is an organization whose foundation is to protect the citizens of our great state," Sen. Perry said.

The LSA 2012 legislative package addressed a number of different issues. Legislation was passed regarding a variety of issues ranging from providing for spousal annuities and benefit increases for retirees to modifying deadlines and the time frame for financial disclosure statements, to name a few.

Senator Perry currently serves as Vice Chairman of Senate Judiciary C Committee. Judiciary C is responsible for matters regarding the administration of criminal justice, the attorney general's office, district attorneys, and prosecutors in general, including compensation, expenses, personnel, and facilities, except retirement matters.
