SET TO TEACH CLASSES ON LEGISLATIVE PROCESS AND THE VALUE OF COMPROMISE

District 26 State Senator Jonathan "J.P." Perry (R-Kaplan) is set to visit with students at North Vermilion High School. Tomorrow, March 7th, from 7:25 - 10:08, he will be instructing two Civics classes on the legislative process. The classes are taught by former State Representative Sammy Theriot. Sen. Perry says that he is honored that former Rep. Theriot invited him into his classroom and that he is excited to visit with the students.

"I am really looking forward to teaching and visiting with some of my most important constituents," said Sen. Perry. "I hope to be able to instruct them on how bills are introduced and answer their questions about the legislative process. I also hope to be able to talk with them about how important it is to be able to compromise, both in everyday life and in the legislature."

Sen. Perry's visit is scheduled in coordination with the America's Legislators Back to School Program, a national bipartisan civic education effort sponsored by the National Conference of State Legislators.
