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01-101 Office of Indian Affairs

The Office of Indian Affairs "seeks to enhance the individual and collective communities of indigenous people in Louisiana by serving as a resource and referral agent for Louisiana Native Americans and tribes seeking assistance navigating local, state, and national policies."

The agency awards scholarships to Native American students. The agency also previously served as a pass through to provide funding to various local entities in Avoyelles Parish for infrastructure

Change from FY17 to FY25 is 80%. (Actual to Recommended) Change from FY17 to FY23 is 50%. (Actual to Actual)

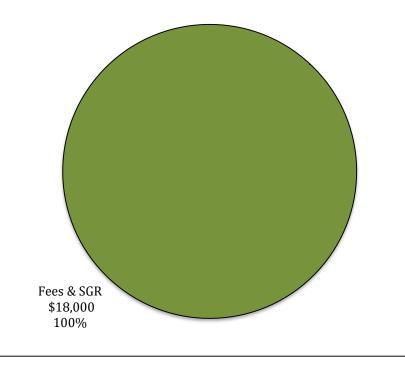

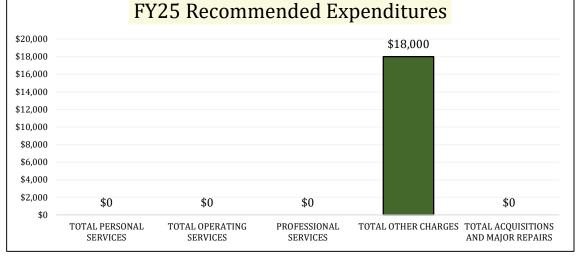
FY25 Source of Funding:

01-101 Office of Indian Affairs Categorical Expenditures at FY25 Recommended

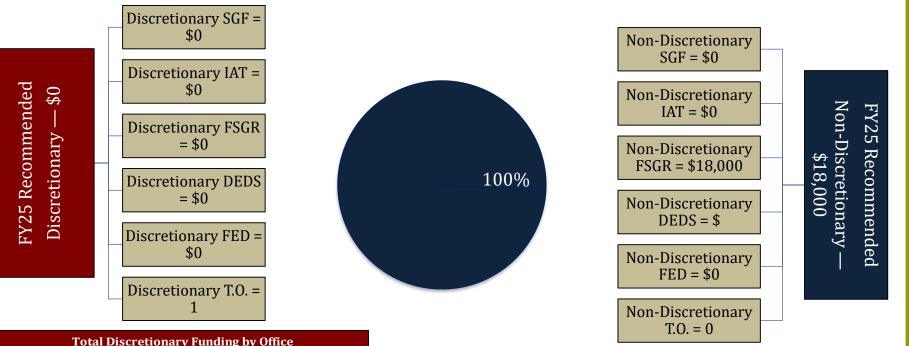
