SENATOR MIKE REESE TAKES OATH OF OFFICE AS NEW DISTRICT 30 STATE SENATOR

Mike Reese is the new state senator for Senate District 30. The Leesville Republican replaces former Senator John Smith. Senator Reese was one of 20 new members sworn in during an organizational session of the Senate at the State Capitol in Baton Rouge yesterday.
